Measurements

- Basic Black (base): 5 ½" x 8 ½", score at 4 ¼"
- Basic Black (layer): 2" x 2 1/8"
- Basic Black: scrap
- Basic White (foil base): 3 ³/₄" x 5"
- Basic White (layer): 2 ½" x 2 ½"
- Basic White (greeting): 1 7/8" x 2"
- Crushed Curry (banner): 1 ½" x 5 ½"
- Crushed Curry: scrap
- Aluminum Foil: 4 ¼" x 5 ½"


Directions

- 1. Emboss the aluminum foil using the embossing folder.
 - a. Place adhesive on the Basic White (foil base).
 - b. Gently apply the embossed aluminum foil to the Basic White (foil base). Wrap the raw ends gently to the back.
 - c. Adhere the layer to the center of the card base using Glue Dots. Do not press down on the foil or you'll de-emboss the image.
- 2. Create a banner tip on one end of the Crushed Curry (banner) cardstock using your scissors.
- 3. Ink the screw image using Crushed Curry ink.
 - a. Stamp off a layer of ink on scratch paper to reduce the color.
 - b. Stamp the image on the Crushed Curry (banner) cardstock.
 - c. Repeat this step until you've filled the banner as desired.
 - d. Adhere the banner near the left side of the aluminum foil layer as shown. Be careful not to press down on the foil around the banner or you'll de-emboss the image.
- 4. Adhere the Basic White (layer) to the Basic Black (layer).
 - a. Adhere the layer to the upper center of the card base using Dimensionals.
- 5. Die cut as follows using scrap cardstock:
 - a. Wrench = Basic Black
 - b. Wrench center, use the solid pencil die = Crushed Curry
 - c. Needle nose plier tips = Basic Black
 - d. Needle nose plier handles = Crushed Curry
- 6. Trim the Crushed Curry pencil die with your scissors so it will fit inside the center of the wrench.
 - a. Adhere to the center of the wrench using liquid glue. Let dry.
- 7. Adhere the needle nose plier tips together using liquid glue. Let dry.
 - a. Adhere the Crushed Curry handles to the bottom of the pliers using liquid glue. Let dry.
- 8. Stamp the hammer image using Memento ink on Crushed Curry scrap cardstock.
 - a. Die cut the hammer using the coordinating die.
 - b. Die cut the hammer again using the Basic Black scrap cardstock.
 - c. Cut the Basic Black hammer at the top of the handle.
 - d. Adhere the black handle to the stamped image using liquid glue. Let dry.

- 9. Adhere the tools vertically across the Basic White (layer) using liquid glue. Let dry.
- 10. Stamp the greeting using Memento ink on the Basic White (greeting) cardstock.
 - a. Adhere the greeting to the Basic Black (greeting) cardstock.
 - b. Adhere the greeting to the lower center of the tools using Dimensionals. Position the greeting so it will hide the raw/cut end of the center of the wrench.
- 11. Place a silver pearl inside the center joint of the needle nose pliers.
